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Organizational contribution:

For participants from Ukraine, the organizational fee for submitting materials to a collective monograph is **UAH 90 per page of text**.

In the case of submission of materials for a collective monograph with a volume of **1.5 printed sheets or more**, the fee will be **UAH 70 per page of text**.

General requirements for design:

1. **The maximum number of authors of one report** is five;
2. **The minimum number of pages** is fifteen;
3. Materials are accepted in MS Word format (.doc/.docx);
4. We accept materials in different languages (the language of submission is not limited). Materials in the language of sanctioned countries are not accepted;
5. **Orientation – portrait only**, landscape orientation is prohibited.;
6. Page – A4. Margins (top, bottom, left, right) – 2 cm;
7. Font – Times New Roman, size (point) – 14, line spacing – 1.5 cm, paragraph 1 cm;
8. **Elements are inherent to the article, they are not formatted.**
9. **Design of figures:** under the title of the figures, the inscription "Source of the figure" or "Source of the figure" must be added.
10. **References:** is drawn up at the end of the material in the order of use of the source in the text under the title "References:" or "References:". The reference list cannot contain references to works published in sanctioned countries.

More detailed information on research design:

1. At the beginning of the work in the upper left corner indicate:
 - the title of the monograph TNR, point 14.
 - the section to which your work belongs.

Example:

Title of the monograph - Sustainable economic development: digital transformation, enterprise development management, ways of renewal and modernization;

Section - Sociology

2. Under the section in the center of the page - the title of the work, bold font, TNR, size 14, in capital letters.

Example:

THE FOUNDATION OF ECONOMIC GROWTH

3. Surname and first name of the author(s) with superscript.

Name of the author(s): bold, font size 14, lowercase, (right-aligned). Affiliation of the author(s): font size TNR, font size 11.

The affiliation of the authors indicates: place of work or study in the nominative case (department, institute, faculty, university, etc.), city and country.

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Example:

Last name Full name¹, Last name Full name², Last name Full name¹

¹name of department/institute/division, name of educational institution, city, country

²name of department/institute/division, name of educational institution, city, country

4. The main text is typed in TNR font, size 14, paragraph - 1 cm, spacing 1.5 cm.

5. Table design: TNR font, size 11-14. The title above the table (Table 1. Table title) is aligned to the right. In the text before the table, there is a reference to the table (text text text text table 1.).

Example:

6. Drawing design: each drawing must be signed and numbered. The text of your work must contain a reference to the drawing, after which the drawing itself is placed, and two inscriptions below it.

Example:

Source of the figure: author's development or [2].

7. References: formed in any style at the author's discretion in the order of citing the source in the text. In the monograph, a general reference list will be formed for the entire work. All sources listed in subsections will be changed in accordance with the general through numbering.

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Submission of materials:

1. Materials are sent to e-mail mono@isg-konf.com. Sign the file name according to the example: Materials_Petrov.
2. After receiving your materials, we check them, edit them (if necessary), agree with the author. After that, we take the payment.
3. The name of the collective monograph must be indicated in the subject of the letter.
